

The CBC Bible Camp Fund Information

The Purpose

The CBC Bible Camp Fund is a designated fund through which Central Baptist Church seeks to assist children, youth and young adults in attending Bible Camps by providing assistance to those who would not normally be able to attend.

Giving to the Fund

The fund exists only through the financial donations of individuals to the fund. Donations to the fund must be made to Central Baptist Church and be enclosed in an envelope designating the money for the Camp Fund. Donations are eligible for income tax receipt. Donations cannot be designated to specific campers.

Who Qualifies for Assistance?

In order to qualify for assistance a person must have attended, or be a relative (child, nephew, niece or grandchild) of a person who has attended CBC for at least 2 months and is entering a recognized Christian camp.

Children attending camp that have previously received assistance from this fund may apply again, but preference will be given to those who have never received assistance. A child may not be supported by this fund more than three times.

Scope of Assistance

Support amounts will be determined by the administrators on a case by case basis, but in principle will not be the entire cost of the camp. Factors that will be taken into account will include, financial need of the applicant, the spiritual need of the applicant, whether or not the child has been to camp before, whether or not the child has been supported by this fund before, the applicant's connection to CBC and the money available in the fund.

Excess fees for specialty camps (such as water ski options at Qwanoes) will not be covered. Support will be sent directly to the camp on behalf of the camper.

How to Apply for Assistance

Any person attending CBC may make a request on behalf of himself or another person. In this case, the person must fill in the CBC Camp Assistance Application Form and submit it to the church office or to a pastor. Because camps fill up quickly, the initial application cut off date will be Mach 15. Applications received after this date will only be considered if money is still available in the account. The applicants will be responsible to register for the camp.
