5. Where does evil try or succeed in creeping into your life?
6. How can you know whether to correct an erring Christian (2:24-26) or to avoid him (3:5)? When should you break fellowship with someone?
7. Since we all tend to be blind to our own hypocrisy, how can we guard against falling into empty religion?
