3. Are you committed to Christ's people? Are you investing your life into others in the church?
4. How is it that Paul exhorted Timothy to grow in the knowledge of God (2 Tim 4:13)? Do you have a regular reading time? Do you read Christian books?
5. When we experience persecution or opposition in the faith, how should we respond? What was Paul's reaction and defense when facing opposition to the message of the gospel (2 Tim 4:14-15)?
6. Ultimately, who kept Paul persevering in the faith and who is able to keep and strengthen us (2 Tim 4:17-18)? Reflect on some ways that God empowers you through the Spirit 'to run the race.'
