1. What did the Spirit teach you through the sermon?
2. How were you taught to pray? By whom?
3. If God is in control and knows what we will pray before we say anything, why bother to pray at all?
4. What does it look like for you to love those in your life who are hard to love?
5. How do we discern what the will of God is?
6. Why is knowledge important for a robust prayer life?
7. Vs 10 reminds believers that there is a future day (“the day of Christ”) when we will stand before God. How should this reminder motivate us to live differently here and now?
