3. Strive together - fight in unity
What should it look like for us to strive together in the spiritual battle God has placed us in?
4. How are you personally seeking to build unity?
5. "Prayer helps us see spiritual things; to see the big picture." How has prayer made otherwise murky things in your life clear?
6. What most discourages you from praying?
7. Do you view prayer as a wartime walkie-talkie or as a bell to call the butler for more iced tea? Discuss how these opposing views might affect your prayer life.
