- Cast vision and mission for the Kids' Ministry at Central Baptist.
- Able to contextualize a gospel based discipleship and not moralize.
- Implement a kids' discipleship plan.
- 2. Team Development
 - Shepherd volunteer leaders by providing care, encouragement, and relational connection.
 - Recruit, train, and equip volunteers on a regular basis.
- 3. Program Oversight
 - Weekly Sunday ministry for children.
 - Pre-youth group ministry for grades 4 through 6.
 - Discipleship for children at the Wednesday night Family Group ministry.
 - Seasonal outreach and discipleship.

- 4. Parental Involvement and Equipping
 - Regularly engage and communicate with parents regarding Kids' Ministry.
 - Create opportunities for parents to invest and participate in their kids' spiritual formation.
- 5. Community Outreach
 - Develop strategies to engage and connect with children in the wider community, providing outreach and invitations to Central.
 - Collaborate with other community organizations to create partnerships that benefit children in our church & community and build connection and trust.
- 6. Practical and Administrative Leadership
 - Use Planning Center software to manage the Kids' Ministry at Central Baptist.
 - Ensure sufficient supplies are in each classroom for the ministry requirements.
 - Ensure Plan to Protect policies are followed.
